#### **Float Rules:**

1. Float judging will begin at 11:30 am. Your float must be "parade ready" at that time for presentation to the judges. If there will be riders/walkers in the parade they must be there and in place at this time for judging.
2. Your float must be "family friendly".
3. No one may get on or off the float once it has started down the parade route.
4. No dangling legs over the edge of the float.
5. There must be a responsible adult present if any children are riding or walking with the float.
6. The driver of the vehicle pulling your float must have a fire extinguisher available. A spotter is also recommended.
7. No real weapons/firearms allowed.
8. The pull vehicle must be able to travel slow enough to avoid stalling.
9. All floats will be judged based on originality, workmanship, and overall appearance and adherence to the theme of the contest.
10. Floats shall not exceed 17 ½ feet in height and 16 feet in width.
11. Adequate primary and secondary connection devices shall be made between the towing vehicle and float.
12. All floats and trailers accompanied by people or animals must have an adult walker beside each tire.
13. Each parade participant in your group must have a release of liability and waiver agreement signed prior to the start of the parade.

#### **Release of Liability & Waiver Agreement:**

In consideration of my or my child's participation, I agree that all activities undertaken by me or my child, are at my or his or her own risk, and that Dan Patch Days Inc, its agents and volunteers, shall not be liable for any claim, demand, injury, damage, action, or causes, of action whatsoever to myself or my child or my property or my child's property due to the passive or active negligence of the Dan Patch Days Inc, its agents, or volunteers, arising out of, connected with my or my child's participation in or the use of operation of equipment in this event and that I expressly forever release and discharge Dan Patch Days Inc, its agents, or volunteers from all such claims, demands, injuries, damages, actions or causes of action whatsoever.
